

6 Within the email you received, click the provided link to verify your account.

- The link will connect you to building out your bidder account information.
- \cdot Use your email address as your Username.
- Create a password for your account.

• Enter your phone number. In order to receive text messages from Online Bidding alerting you when you have been out-bid on an item, you must include your Mobile Phone.

• Enter your credit card information. This is required to allow you to bid on items and/or make a donation.

- You will only be charged if you make a donation via our online bidding site or if you are the winning bidder on a silent auction item.

- The company we use for our online bidding (Greater Giving) is a PCI-Level 1 Compliant credit card processing company. Your card information is securely stored and then removed from our database after the event.

· Confirm all information is correct and then click the "Create" button at the bottom of the page.

Your account is now created and you are ready to bid on our great silent auction items!


All items must be picked up at the Regis Catholic Schools Central Office


