UPDAL

Our schools will generally be closed when the public schools in the district where the school is located are closed due to inclement weather. Late starts or early releases due to inclement weather follow the same policy.

Closure decisions are shared via local TV and radio stations, along with an email and SMS (text) message alert via Skylert.

In order to receive SMS (text) messages from Regis Catholic Schools to the cell phone number(s) you have on file, you <u>must opt-in via your phone.</u>

You can opt-in to receive SMS (text) messages anytime by sending Y or YES to short code 67587. If you already completed the opt-in process at a previous time, you do not need to repeat it for this year. Our opt-in list carries over from year to year.


