Academic and Career Planning (ACP)

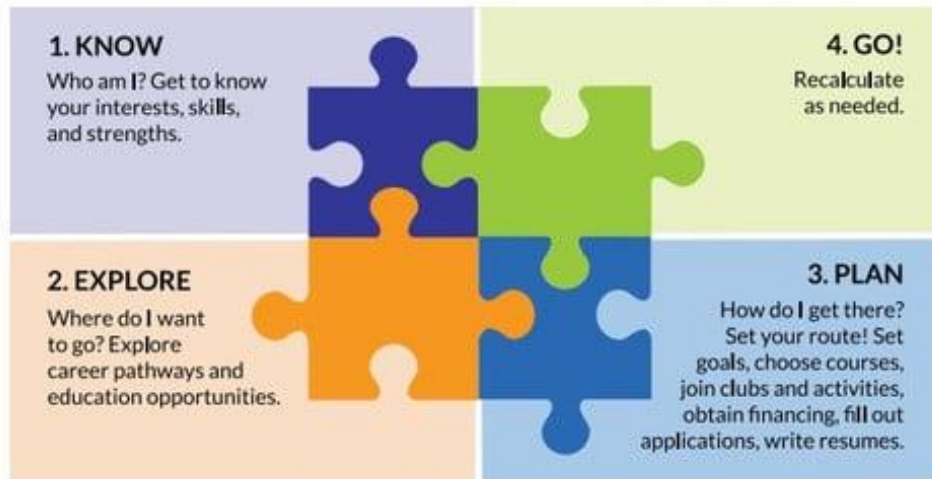

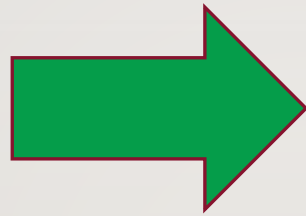

- Not all options work in schedules or are appropriate for all students

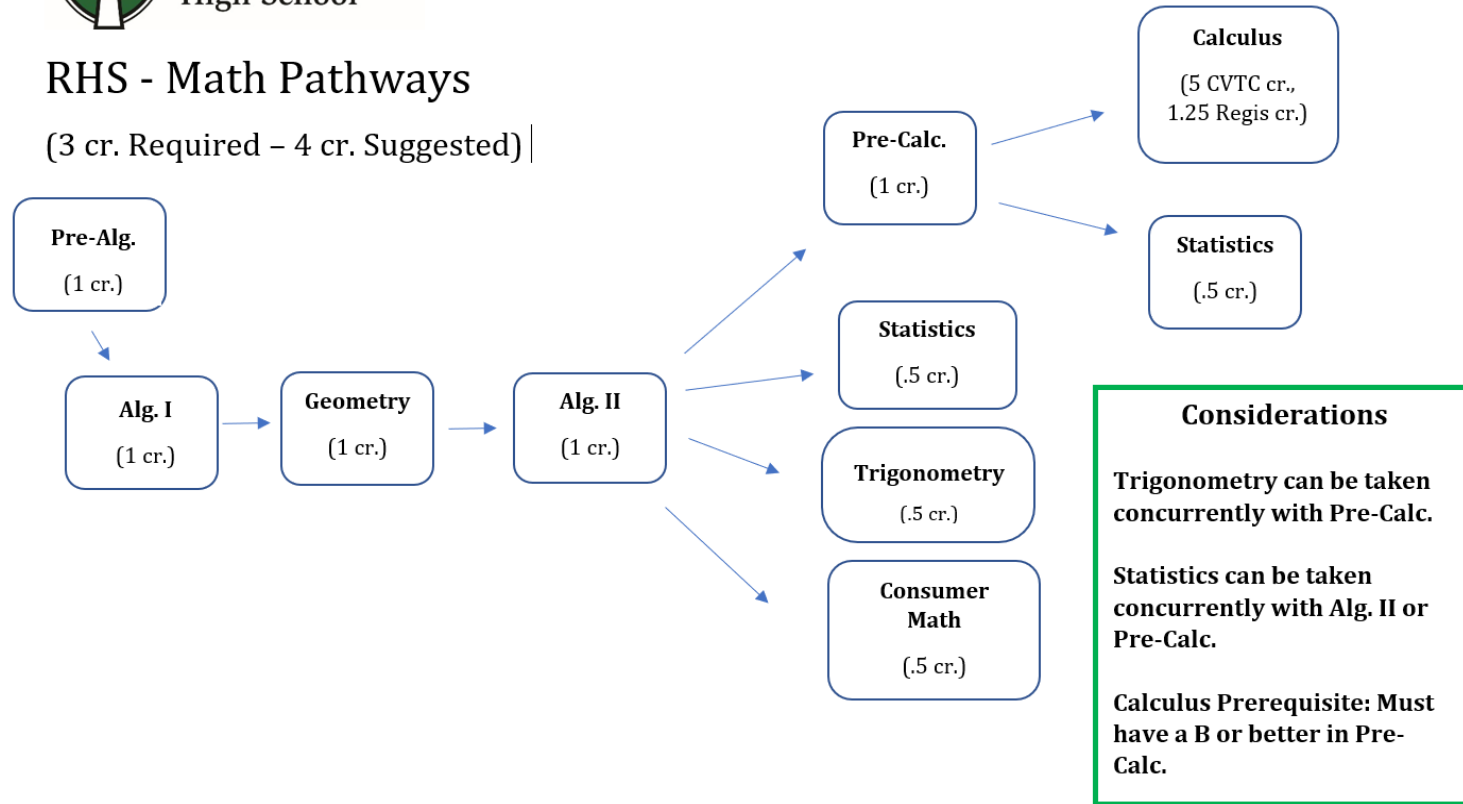

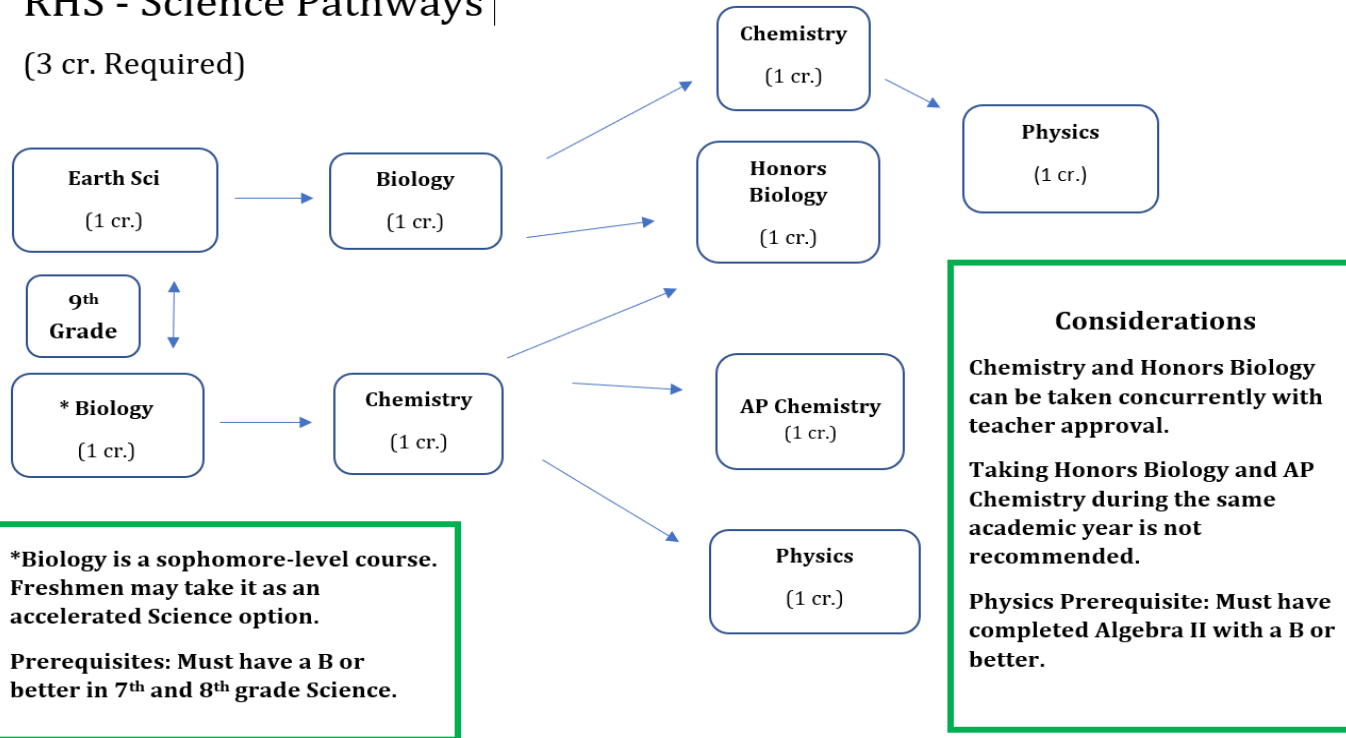

About

- WVS online courses are aligned to national and state standards.
- Wisconsin-certified teachers teach all courses.
- Most core classes are NCAA-approved.
- Weekly check-ins with students and coaches.
- Each semester-long WVS course is .5 Regis credit
- \$290/semester - Regis pays for the course if it is successfully completed with a C or better.
Courses not passed at a C or better are the financial responsibility of the student/family.
 - Students not able to register for additional online courses if below a C

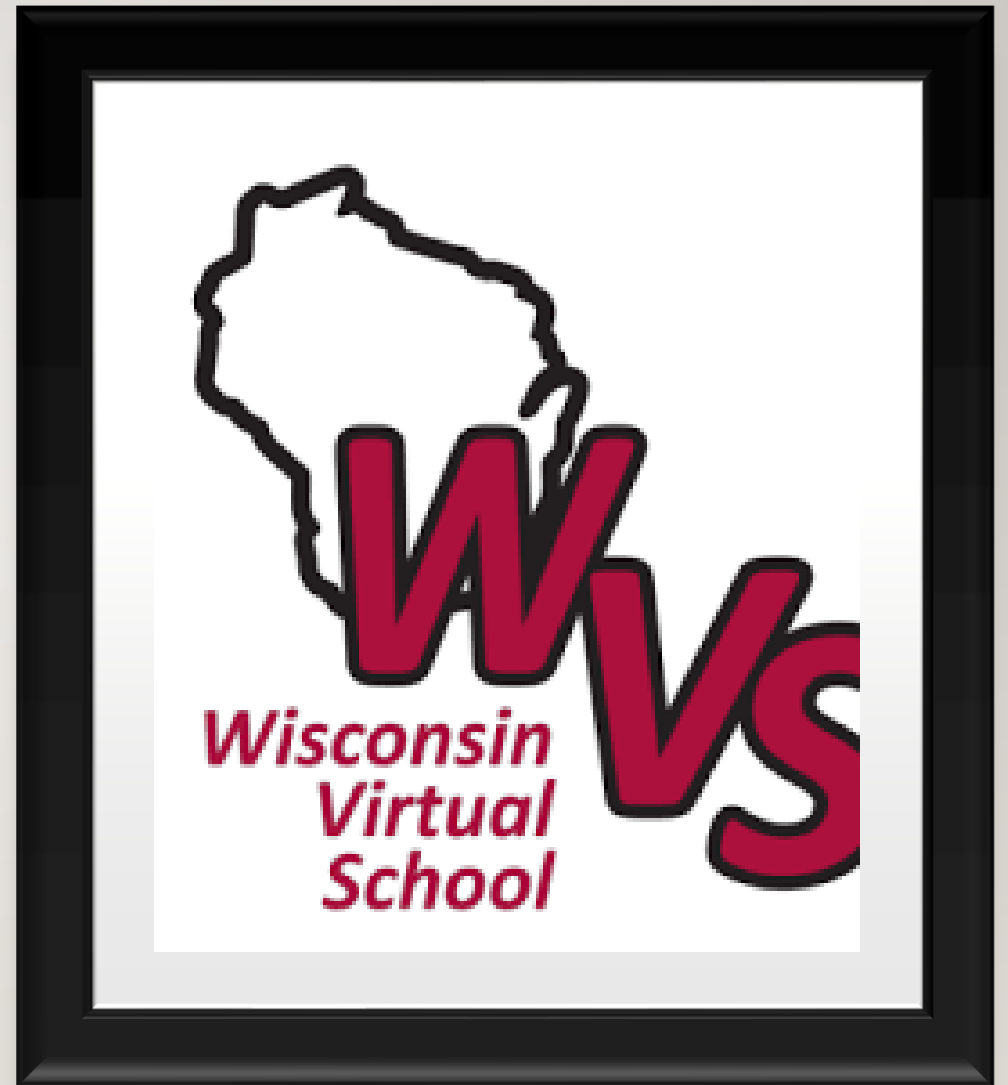

 - May lead to certification
- Taught off-campus or online
- Available for 9-12 graders
 - Many are not available until 11th grade
- Courses not passed at a C or better are the financial responsibility of the student/family
 - Students not able to register for additional academies
- **Discuss with the Registrar or Administration before enrolling**
- Courses can not be dropped after Aug. 30

- Make sure you meet enrollment requirements
- Go to:

 - Explore Available Academies for Fall 2024 or Spring 2025
 - Make sure the Academy courses fit within your RHS requirements
 - Make sure you meet any prerequisites.
- Make an appointment with the RHS Registrar to verify that you are eligible for the Academy
- Turn in your signed CVTC course contract to the RHS Registrar and your preferred payment option – (check/credit card)
 - prerequisites



About

- Available to 11th and 12th graders who meet the requirements established for participation.
- The student must be on track for graduation, and the course requested **may not be similar to a course offered at Regis High School.**
- For courses at UWEC, students must rank in the top 25% of their class OR rank in the top 50% with an ACT 24 or greater.
- Students may earn up to 18 post-secondary credits TOTAL between the ECCP/SCN during their high school career.
- **Registration Deadlines – Non-negotiable**
 - April 1 for the fall semester
 - November 1 for the spring semester

Enrollment Considerations

Tuition and textbook costs will be 100% paid by Regis if the student passes with a grade of "C" or better.

Courses not passed at a C or better are the financial responsibility of the student and family.

The class must be able to be worked into the student's schedule at Regis High School.

Must have own transportation and written approval from a parent or guardian.

The student must not have any disciplinary problems at either Regis High School or the receiving school.

Each UWEC credit is worth .25 Regis credit
(ex: 3 CVTC cr. = .75 Regis cr.)

STEPS TO ENROLL IN EARLY COLLEGE CREDIT PROGRAM - UWEC

- Make an appointment with the RHS Registrar to verify that you are eligible for ECCP
- Go to:

 - Make a list of courses you are interested in – Select multiple options (Student responsibility!)
- Complete ECCP Registration Paperwork – available in the RHS Registrar's office
- Turn in your signed UWEC course contract to the RHS Registrar

- Available to 11th and 12th graders who meet the requirements established for participation.
- The student must be on track for graduation, and the course requested **may not be similar to a course offered at Regis High School.**
- Must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.
- Students may earn up to 18 post-secondary credits TOTAL between the ECCP/SCN during their high school career.
- **Registration Deadlines – Non-negotiable**
 - By March 1 for the fall semester
 - By October 1 for the spring semester
- Courses can not be dropped after Aug. 30th

- Make sure you meet enrollment requirements

 - Make a list of courses you are interested in
 - Verify that they fit within your RHS requirements and schedule
 - Make sure you meet any prerequisites.
- Make an appointment with the RHS Registrar to verify your eligibility for the Start College Now. Complete the SCN Registration Paperwork, which is available in the RHS Registrar's office.
- Turn in your signed CVTC paperwork to the RHS Registrar and your preferred payment option – (check/credit card)

ADDITIONAL THINGS TO CONSIDER

- **1. What is your dream college?**
 - Get familiar with Transferology (<https://www.transferology.com/index.htm>)
 - Students can see how courses may transfer nationwide from public and private colleges.
- **What credits and AP scores will transfer?**
 - UW-Madison: Students who take college courses prior to high school graduation (this includes dual enrollment) will receive advanced credit at UW-Madison as long as the credit is 1) transferable, 2) earned at an accredited college, and 3) listed on an official transcript generated by the college. AP Scores of 3, 4, or 5.
 - Rice University: The college courses on the official college transcript must not have been used to meet high school graduation requirements and must not appear on your high school transcript as dual credit. English Composition courses are not eligible for transfer; Rice's First-Year Writing-Intensive Seminar (FWIS) is required of all first-year students. Mathematics courses below *Calculus I* do not transfer. AP Scores of 4 or
- **Maturity** – with ECCP and SCN, parents can no longer access grades, assignments, attendance, etc.
 - Anxiety/stress level of students. What is developmentally appropriate for your child?

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION

- **Why do I have to pay anything for dual credits when I am paying for Regis tuition?**
 - Your tuition costs cover the 26 credits required for your child to obtain a high school diploma from Regis Catholic Schools. The cost to educate a student in secondary education in the state of Wisconsin is \$12,740. Regis High School tuition for the 2023-24 school year is \$6,945.
- **What about equity?**
 - RHS is committed to allowing all students equal opportunity to challenging academic options. All AP courses (taught at RHS and online via WVS) are free. Tuition and textbook costs with ECCP are also 100% paid by Regis if participation requirements are met.
 - RHS is establishing a Scholarship Fund for students who wish to enroll in dual credit options but have financial limitations. These situations will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
