2023 Tuition Tax Deduction Information

When filing for 2023, taxpayers may deduct the private and religious school tuition expenses they have paid up to \$4,000 for each dependent child in grades K-8 and up to \$10,000 for each dependent child in grades 9-12. The tuition expenses must have been paid on or after January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.
