  - i. At their last meeting, they discussed the impact of the School Choice (Voucher) program and also the Diocesan religious assessments

  - ii. Annual Fund is at \$190,161 and COEP is at \$74,000 (all as of 4/1/14). 100 families contributed to COEP and 48 indicated they are not giving.

# g. AdvancEd Accreditation Visit – Renee Cassidy

 Renee passed out the RCS Accreditation Report and schedule for the visitation on April 6-9. The team will give their final report and recommendation at the 11am meeting on Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>. All commission members are welcome.

### h. Enrollment – Teresa Johnson

 Distributed enrollment report – early enrollment period comparison this year and last year, and the current enrollment numbers. We are up compared to last year at the same time.

### i. Finances - Denise Boos

- i. Finance Committee approved to revise the Distance Learning Policy (\$50 per credit cost to parent). Parents will be paying 40% of the cost overall (they will prepay entire cost and RCS will reimburse after course completion).
- ii. 3 teachers committed to the St. Mary's University Master's degree program
- iii. \$13,000 remaining of the Pavelski/Lawler estates and the finance committee and pastors approved using the funds to pay down the debt to the Diocese.
