Middle School Binder System

Key Components of the Binder:

- One or two binders between 1-2 inches wide with heavy duty rings
- One or two packages of loose leaf paper (optional: college or wide ruled; reinforced loose leaf)
- Minimum 8 tabbed plastic pocket dividers in assorted colors (preferred: green, red, blue, yellow, purple)

Assembly of the Binder

- Each class will have a different color divider and should be labeled with the name of the class. Students will label their dividers and organize their binder on the first day of school. No preparation is needed.
- Place 20-50 sheets of loose leaf paper behind the dividers at the back of the binder for use as needed in classes.
- Leave the front pocket of each divider open to store current homework or work that needs to be turned in.

Using the Binder

- As teachers provide notes and handouts in class, place them into the rings behind the divider with the newest material on top.
- Avoid using the pockets of the divider as a folder. Materials from class should be 3-hole punched and filed in the rings.
- Each evening, spend a few minutes with your binder to organize any loose material. Also take this time to read through the new material presented in class that day. Make notations or highlight important concepts on handouts. You only need to spend a few minutes on each class, unless other homework was assigned.
- Use your planner to record daily assignments and plan long-term projects.
- Teachers will designate times to remove old materials from the binder and store in a safe place at home or in your locker for use later.
