# **Report** from the Dean



"I hope that we remember Advent is truly a penitential season of watching and waiting, rather than one of busyness or self-indulgence."

It is hard to believe that I have already completed one year of service as Dean and am well into my seventh year as a member of the Regis family. By now most people know how utterly committed I am both to Catholic identity and to academic rigor. I am quite happy to report that, the more involved I get as Dean, the more I encounter people on our Regis team who pursue that twofold goal with great competency.

Our students also never cease to amaze me. This year we have several kindergartners who are telling their parents to ask Saint Nick to bring them a Bible at Christmas.

Speaking of Saint Nicholas, earlier this month I found myself doubled over with laughter and seriously impressed at the same time. We were celebrating the "All Saints' Day Meet and Greet" sponsored by the 4th grade class at St. Mary's Elementary. Each student dressed up as a different Saint. Following Mass, we went to the parish hall, where the "Saints" set up displays and held question and answer sessions with their visitors.

I thought I was being clever and mischievous by going up to Saint Nicholas, pretending to flinch and shield my face, and begging, "Please don't punch me!" This was a reference to the Council of Nicea in 325, attended by over 300 bishops from all over the empire. Arius and his followers were promoting the false belief that Jesus was somehow less than God. Allegedly, the Bishop of Myra, jolly old Saint Nick himself, was so upset that he struck Arius a blow. This has become a rather popular meme on December 6th the last few years, with images of the Saint saying things like, "I came to give presents to kids and to punch heretics – and I just ran out of presents..."

Needless to say, I was totally floored when the 4th grader responded without missing a beat: "I would never punch anyone unless he denied that Jesus was truly divine." Now there is a kid who has done his homework!

He also eagerly taught students and parents alike about the real Saint Nicholas, so much more fascinating than "Santa Claus." He told stories of Saint Nicholas giving generously to the poor, anonymously obtaining dowries for young women, saving three innocent men from execution, and much more.

As we enter another "holiday" cycle, I hope that each of us can learn, as our students do, the real meaning of each holiday and each season. I hope that we are totally committed to keeping Thanksgiving as a day of expressing gratitude to God and spending time with loved ones. I hope that we remember Advent is truly a penitential season of watching and waiting, rather than one of busyness or self-indulgence. Above all else, I hope we all remember to be like the Blessed Virgin Mary this Christmas, pondering these holy mysteries in our hearts and cherishing the mighty things God has done for us.

In advance, I wish each of you a grace-filled Advent Season and a very Merry Christmas.

# **Report** from the President

"Our goal is, and always will be, to provide the safest educational environment possible for your children."



The first quarter has flown by and I confidently report that is has been a super start to the year! Our K-12 enrollment has climbed to more than 800 for the first time in a couple of years. In addition, our two child development centers are at capacity. This is good news, especially the fact that the increased enrollment is mainly happening in our elementary schools.

As far as update on our facilities, the Track & Field of Dreams has been operational despite awaiting a few final additions. The last thing will be a dedication wall to our generous donors who helped make the upgrade a reality. The reason we will be having a ceremony in August of 2019 is that we want to make sure to give opportunity for contributors to be recognized since we will be closing the solicitation of funds in June of 2019. Heartfelt thanks to those who have already sent in their pledges. Work continues on the upgrades to our security systems in all four buildings, most of which will be completed by the end of January. St. James Elementary will be having the most improvements with the addition of a new public communication system linking the entire building.

Finally, I want to give thanks to our teaching staff. In October, the statewide ACT scores were released for the



2018 graduating class and our Regis students had a composite score of 24.7. The statewide composite was 20.5. Our score was also the highest by a sizable margin over every other institution other than McDonell, which finished a small percent behind. It is typical for McDonell or Regis to have the highest score from year to year. This academic achievement reflects on the dedication and rigor from our entire K-12 faculty. These results, combined with involved parents and a faith-based approach, prove you do not need to have all the bells and whistles to provide a quality education with a high degree of post-secondary preparedness. Thank you for all your support to make this possible.



# School Safety Grant + School Safety Improvements



We are happy to announce Regis Catholic Schools was awarded \$100,945 as part of the first round of Wisconsin Department of Justice School Safety Grants.

Representatives from Regis Catholic Schools attended a special press conference with Attorney General Brad Schimel in July. The grant money is being used to help upgrade security features at each one of our schools. In addition, Regis Catholic Schools was also awarded an additional \$47,370 in September as part of the second round of Wisconsin Department of Justice School Safety Grants. These funds will be used to establish recommended requirements for a mental health training program. We will continue screening all of our elementary aged students for mental health needs twice a year.







Howard was a teacher at Regis beginning in the mid-1970s. He taught Government, Social Studies, and German. Many of the Regis graduates remember making the "German trip" with Howard! Regis students had a great cultural experience and created a lot of memories as they learned from Howard on those trips. Howard also served as a Senior Class Advisor, organizing graduation and Homecoming for many years. He also organized the annual Gold Mass for the Salvation Army, which continues today. He also coached the High Quiz Bowl team, Mock Trial team, and the Regis Golf team during his time at Regis. His teaching was legendary, earning him the "Regis Teacher of the Year" award on numerous occasions.

"After teaching at Regis for 43 years and attending St. James Elementary and Regis High School with nine siblings, we know just how much the Catholic schools in Eau Claire have enriched our lives. Now, more than ever, we strongly believe Catholic schools are needed and worth the sacrifice families often have to make.



"I took over as the Director of what was Home Away From Home in 1997," said Gayle Flaig, Administrator of the Early Childhood Programs for Regis Catholic Schools. "At that time, it was a child care center owned and operated by Sacred Heart Parish."

This original facility was located just behind the current Genesis Child Development Center which, at that time, was the Sacred Heart Elementary School. 1998 brought the consolidation of the Eau Claire and Altoona Catholic schools, and the Bishop decided to close Sacred Heart Elementary.

"On September 20, 1998, the child care center moved into the then vacant elementary school and was renamed as the Genesis Child Development Center," Flaig said.

The program was originally licensed by the State of Wisconsin for 75 children. In the last 20 years, it has grown and expanded and is now licensed for 107 children.

"I consider it an honor and a privilege that parents entrust us with their children," Flaig said. "It is a responsibility I don't take lightly."

Today, the Genesis Child Development Center serves as a training site for students from the Chippewa Valley Technical College. It also collaborates with the Eau Claire Area School District to provide a top-notch 4K program.

"The care and education children receive during the first five years of life have profound learning benefits," Flaig said. "My mission is to never lose sight of what is important. What drives me forward every day

is a commitment to do what is right for the children in our care."




# Fall Sports Report





In August of 2014, Christine was diagnosed with stage 4 colorectal cancer. After her diagnosis, she underwent continuous treatment at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. She fought a long and courageous battle, never giving up on her positive outlook on life.

Christine attended Imaculate Conception Elementary School and was a 2003 graduate from Regis High School. Christine worked at the Genesis Child Development Center for 4 1/2 years. She worked in different classrooms, including infants, three year olds, and 4K.

She developed strong relationships with not only the children in her care but also the families she worked with. Christine was very helpful in organizing center events,

such as the Scholastic Book Fair.

Christine enjoyed cake decorating, crafts, knitting, crocheting, writing, singing, and the outdoors.

Her family, friends, and coworkers will always remember her courage to "Fight it (cancer) like a Beast".

Christine's sister, Sarah, is also a teacher at the Genesis Child Development Center.


