This past school year was another great season of accomplishments for many of our sports teams and student athletes. Many athletic teams and individuals won conference, regional and sectional championships, and the Regis Football Team finished an undefeated season as D7 State Champions! Additionally, the boys 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams were State Champions and set a state record in the 4x200 race. Members of the relay teams were Ian Andrews, Alex Figy, Everett Tait, and Carson Tait. Other Track and Field State place winners included Carson Tait (4<sup>th</sup>) and Alex Figy (7<sup>th</sup>) in the 100-meter dash, and Everett Tait (5<sup>th</sup>) in the 200-meter dash. Lady Rambler Carly Borst placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the 400-meter dash, 7<sup>th</sup> in the 100-meter dash, and 10<sup>th</sup> in the 200-meter dash. The Regis Girls Cross Country Team of Carly Borst, Sylvia Spangler, Ashley Chilson, Ava Moore, Violet Roen, and Rebecca Catt placed 14<sup>th</sup> at State, and the Girls Tennis Teams continued their success by qualifying two individuals for State singles play, Brittany Martin and Colleen Callaghan, and the doubles team of Teigan Petersilka and Olivia Zavaleta. On the boys' side of the net, Senior Alex Erickson qualified for State Tennis singles play. Congratulations to all our student athletes and coaches on their achievements both on and off the field, and we look forward to the continued success of our sports teams and athletes during the 2023-2024 season – GO RAMBLERS!
