IV. New Business

A. Enrollment Season Open

1. Going well-See enrollment report for specifics on numbers.
2. WPCP-We have had a good turn out for our first week of open enrollment for that.

B. Accreditation Updates

C. Central Office Efficiencies

1. Central Office looking to take over billing, tuition, and enrollment to aid the child development centers to improve efficiency and the system as a whole.

D. Student Information System (SIS) 2027-2028

1. Our current system is Skyward for SIS-we are currently considering a shift to a new Skyward program Qmlativ, in addition to consideration of other programs.
2. The transition is 2 years away and we are currently in the research phase.

3. Staff inservice will occur as we make the transition.

E. Regis v 5th Grade Basketball

1. System wide event with all students from Regis to watch the Regis varsity basketball players play the fifth grade students.
 - a) This was the first time at the gym for this tradition.
2. Positive feedback from students and staff with notes for improvement for future events.

F. Faith Night - Express

1. Sunday, May 31st with Eau Claire Express-Faith Night.
2. How do we make tickets for students and families able to attend for free (through registration)?
 - a) A donation is covering 630 tickets for families who are interested in attending.
 - b) Regis Sponsor \$1000
 - (1) Table with swag at entrance
 - (2) 100 Loaded Tickets-seat, hotdog, and soda
 - (3) We will have a registration link for families above 100 people.
 - (4) It will be advertised in April.

V. Old Business

A. NCEA 2026

1. April 7-8 for all Regis contracted staff-registration and transportation provided (using Title II funding).
2. It is a great PD opportunity for our staff.

B. Staff Increases Update

1. Projected 7% tuition rate increase would allow for teacher wages to go up 3%.
2. This was brought to Finance Committee
3. The 7% increase in tuition would generate \$270,000.
4. Teacher wages increased 3% and would cost \$161,000 (without steps, lanes, hourly, payroll taxes, benefits).
5. The finance committee encouraged exploration by 4% which would cost \$187,000 (still without the extra expenses listed in #4).
6. Base pay for Regis is 67% of the public schools base pay rate.

C. Chief Learning Officer (CLO) Update

1. This position is actively posted and we have 3 final applicants with Arcadia.
2. In person interviews will take place at the end of this month for these individuals. One of these candidates will likely be chosen for CLO.

3. CLO could become the interim president or interim principal as the principal search continues to be ongoing.

D. Arcadia Updates

1. Working with Arcadia and building administrators on an evaluating tool with practice.
2. Arcadia is in town on 2/20 to work with our building administrators.
3. Appreciation for transparency for the survey letters was stated.
 - a) There was an for more transparency with an honest Arcadia update for parents in a similar letter. Paul plans to communicate with Arcadia about a plan to be more transparent with families.
 - b) There are a lot of questions regarding the specifics of what Arcadia is doing, where the money is going, etc.
 - c) 1 donor is footing the bill for Arcadia's services-not Regis.
