School is almost here! The first full day of school is Thursday, August 31st. We will start the first full day with a morning meeting in the cafeteria. Open House is a required "dropin" day on Wednesday, August 30th. Parents and students can stop by from 11:30am-3:30pm to meet their teachers, bring in school supplies, find their lockers, and return back to school mailing materials. The first day of school is Thursday, August 31st, 8:30am-3:30pm.

- Opening Prayer and Announcements begin at 8:30am in the cafeteria. Parents are invited to attend this all school community event. Students will be escorted to their classrooms by their teachers after announcements.
- Parents are invited to a Social Gathering in the Oak Room at 8:45am.
- Morning Meeting will only take place on Mondays. On Mondays, please drop students off at Door 6, where they should report to the cafeteria. Parents are welcome to attend on Mondays with their students. Every other day of the week, students should enter door 5 and report directly to their classrooms. Parents are asked not to remain in the hallways or classrooms after the beginning bell at 8:30.
- At 3:30pm dismissal, parents should pick up their child(ren) in the gym not in the classrooms or hallways. The students will line up in their designated lines.
- Reminder regarding attendance: Your child's attendance at school is extremely important. We understand absences occur as a normal part of any school year, however we ask you to make every effort to schedule appointments and vacations during anticipated school breaks. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction defines a student truant when they have missed 10 days of school, excused or unexcused, in a given school year. You will receive notification from us when your child has missed 5, 7 and 10 or more days of school. We will make every effort to work with you to improve your child's attendance.

Attention Parents with Regis Middle School Students!

Your middle school children are welcome to wait for parents at IC after school. However, we ask that you only send your middle schooler to IC if you have children who still attend IC or are a staff member at IC. Students are expected to wait calmly and quietly for their parents. They are not to play sports in the gym. This area is not supervised until 3:15.

Students who are arriving at IC for sports practices are not allowed to enter the building until their coach arrives. They should wait for their coach outside Door 6.
