Dear Families,

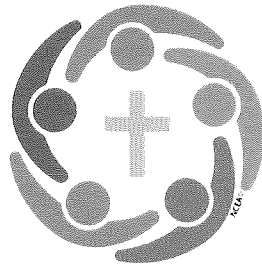
Happy New Year! I hope you all have a blessed Christmas.
