Dear Immaculate Conception Families,

We are happy to inform you that Immaculate Conception Elementary School will begin offering the Weekend Kid's Meals Program. This program is offered through Feed My People Food Bank.

- The purpose of the program is to provide food for your child during the weekend when school breakfasts and lunches are not available.
- There are no income guidelines or requirements. Anyone is welcome to participate in this program. The food is at NO COST to you or your child.
- If you choose to enroll your child, they will receive a plastic bag each Friday with food for breakfast and lunch for Saturday and Sunday, plus snacks and fresh fruit.
- Please be aware that Feed My People does not screen for allergens. Please consider your own safety when enrolling in this program. In a food bank warehouse, we are unable to guarantee cross contamination and exposure to various food allergens (tree nut peanut, milk, egg, wheat, soy, corn, etc.).
