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Instructional Setting

Regis High School serves 227 students in grades 9-12 in average classes of 20 students. There are three classrooms of each grade level. Our average attendance rate is 88%. Throughout the course of an 8 period school day, students are engaged in coursework in English, Math, Theology, Science, Social Studies, Art, Music, Business, Physical Education & Health, and World Languages. Additionally, there are many opportunities to earn dual college credit in high school.

Each year, the Wisconsin Department of Instruction releases school report cards for each district in the state.

As part of the state accountability system, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) produces report cards for every publicly funded school and district in Wisconsin. These Accountability Report Cards include data on multiple indicators for multiple years across four Priority Areas (Student Achievement, Growth, Closing Gaps, and On-track and Post-Secondary Success).

In addition, given the impact on student success, the Accountability Report Cards also measure chronic absenteeism and dropout rates. A school or district's Overall Accountability Score places the school/district into one of five Overall Accountability Ratings.

Please note that because we do not receive an all-school report card, only students who attend Regis Catholic Schools under the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program will have data on the report card. Some schools, because of the size or grade range, do not have enough data to receive a score. Private schools with insufficient data are not rated. We have published the information below in an effort to transparently communicate accurate information about our state assessment performance.
