Service Hour Criteria

25 hours of service are required at RHS each year – forms are due by June 1st. The emphasis of this work should be “outreach” to our community, primarily with non-profit organizations. In order to graduate, each student must have their service hours completed.

1. 5 hours are to be at your Parish. This is your way to thank your parish for their continued support of our Regis Catholic Schools. Examples: Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Choir, Fish Boils, Bible Camps, Sunday School, Church Bazaar, Altar Server, Parish chores, or Regis Mass Altar Server. (Students who are not a member of a parish or congregation are still required to complete 25 hours annually.)
2. 20 hours are to be community based, primarily with non-profit organizations. Examples: Scouts, Community Table, Food Pantry, Humane Association, Salvation Army, Regis Events, Sacred Heart Hospital, City of EC Clean Up Days, Mayo Health Systems, Chippewa Valley Museum, Beaver Creek Reserve, LE Phillips Library, Peer Tutoring, etc.
3. Bring this Service Hours Form to your service date. You need to have the organization’s supervisor sign your form. If you forget the form, have them write a note for you.
4. Babysitting, store and classroom clean up and household chores do not meet the criteria.
5. Specific dates should be listed. Do not list a general time period.
6. Turn your forms into the Regis High School Service Learning Coordinator as you complete them. Do not wait until the last minute to turn them in.
7. All service hours are subject to approval.
