

Our schools have been off to a quiet, yet productive start to this 2016-17 academic year. Despite the recent teacher shortage, the principals have done a marvelous job in procuring a solid staff. The new staff have blended in nicely with our veteran teachers and we thank our Regis community for their support. Thanks to the efforts of the players and the coaches, I no longer have to struggle to come up with a pertinent closing. The so called 'football experts' around the state considered the size and experience of the opponent and deemed us to be sizeable underdogs. What they learned, which we already knew, is that you never underestimate a Rambler! Congratulations to the squad for bringing the gold ball back to Regis! This is just a morsel of many success stories, such as the Girls Tennis team's runner-up finish at the state tourney this fall and the One Act Play cast garnering an All-State recognition in November. # ACCREDITATION REPORT



AdvancED continues to highlight the outstanding progress and planning at Regis Catholic Schools.

We submitted a progress report in May 2016 and the AdvancED Accreditation Board responded with positive feedback.

Listed below are the commendations from AdvancED.

1. Regis Catholic Schools was commended for hiring a Pupil Services Director to assist students and faculty with special needs. Meeting the unique learning styles of diverse students has sufficiently improved with coordinating learning support services.

2. Regis Catholic Schools has implemented various programs to collect data to identify and monitor students' progress. The Curriculum Coordinator meets regularly with faculty to review the information and assess learning.

3. Regis Catholic Schools has trained faculty to analyze three years of standardized test scores with the assistance of the Curriculum Coordinator and Pupil Services Director. Continued staff development is ongoing to regularly review provided data and assess both strengths and weaknesses for improve student learning.

Regis Catholic Schools follows the criteria of high standards set by AdvancED. The norms for accreditation illustrate evidence and progress to improve student learning. Each year, a submission of reports is completed stating that we follow the accreditation standards. In three years, AdvancED will complete another audit of our practices. In support of our Core Values, we continue to follow best educational practices through accreditation.

AdvancED is a non-profit, non-partisan organization that conducts rigorous on-site external reviews of Pre-K-12 schools and school systems to ensure that all learners realize their full potential.

## 5TH GRADE BAND PROGRAM RETURNS

Regis Catholic Schools is elated to bring back the band program to students in 5th grade! Studies have shown learning to play a musical instrument has a strong positive effect on brain development, and we are glad to be able to offer this opportunity.

Students at Immaculate Conception Elementary, St. James Elementary and St. Mary's Elementary are participating in weekly lessons and a monthly group lesson. In all, almost 50% of eligible students are participating in the program!

Mrs. Mecikalski, our music teacher at St. James Elementary and St. Mary's Elementary, has taken on this wonderful endeavor. We are blessed to have her patient, loving guidance for our students. She certainly is an additional reason students love learning to create music to glorify our Lord!








